## AZ Speaks Promotion

Arizona Humanities requires host organizations to promote each program and make every effort to ensure good attendance. All promotional materials (flyers, press releases, websites, postcards, etc.) **must display the Arizona Humanities logo or include the phrase, “This program is made possible by Arizona Humanities.”** Logos are available in this toolkit.

## America250 Promotion

Arizona Humanities requires that host organizations **must display the America250 logo and/or include the phrase, “This project is in support of the America 250th initiative to celebrate and commemorate the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence.”** Logo as available in this toolkit.

## Arizona Commission on the Arts Promotion

Arizona Humanities requires host organization to display the Arizona Commission on the Arts logo and include the phrase, **“This project is supported in part by the Arizona Commission on the Arts with funding provided by the National Endowment for the Arts through its America250 initiative.”** *This is only required if the host site has booked a speaker labeled as “artist”.* Logos are available in this toolkit.

## Institute of Museum and Library Services & Arizona State Library Promotion

Arizona Humanities requires host organization to display the ILMS & Arizona State Library logos and include the phrase, **“This project is supported in part by the Arizona State Library, Archives and Public Records, a division of the Secretary of State, with federal funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services.”** *This is only required if the host site is a library.* Logos are available in this toolkit.

To help publicize your program, **begin marketing 4-6 weeks in advance** and consider the following:

- Create a flyer/poster/postcard for your venue
- Announce the program on your website
- Add it to community calendars
- Send an email to your mailing list
- Submit a press release to local media

- Share on social media
- Notify local schools, city council, libraries, tourism board, chamber of commerce, and professional newsletters
- Invite elected officials or their staff to attend
